AQA A Level course is a full two year course, awarding A Level certificate.
The examination for assessment is conducted at the end of two years.

Yr 12 (AS) Contents

There are 4 Units, specifically

1. Biological molecules
- 2 Cells
- 3 Organisms exchange substances
with their environment
- 4 Genetic information, variation
and relationships between organisms

You will be asked to perform six required practicals in this year and will be internally assessed.

Apart from this requirement, you will have the opportunity to do other practicals too.

Yr 13 (A2) Contents:

There are 4 Units.

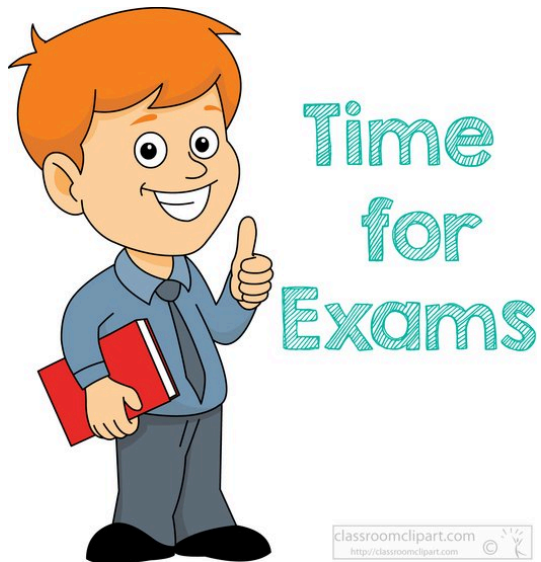
1. Energy transfers in and between organisms
2. Organisms respond to changes in their internal and external environments
3. Genetics, populations, evolution and ecosystems
4. The control of gene expression

You will be asked to perform six required practicals in this year and will be internally assessed.
Apart from this requirement, you will have the opportunity to do other practicals too.

External Assessment

At the end of two years, you will sit for the external examination as detailed below.

Three Papers in total.



Paper 1 : (2 hrs.) for 91 marks

Paper 2 : (2 hrs.) for 91 marks

Paper 3 : (2 hrs.) for 78 marks
